Media Release: 'dust2dust' stars cast

Award-winning filmmaker Michael Korican has cast Victorians Viktoria Believein and Ernest Warnelius to star in his latest short film 'dust2dust'.

'dust2dust' is a short psychological thriller about death and memory and was one of two projects selected by CineVic for its Auteur Series this year. The project will be shot on Ultra 16mm film and aims for exposure on the film festival circuit.

Michael Korican graduated from York University film school with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Film Production. His last film 'i luv spam' had its World Premiere at the 2008 Victoria Film Festival. Michael says, "I've had the idea for 'dust2dust' for many years. It's wonderful to be bringing it to life now, on film no less."

Viktoria Believein has appeared in two local films and one play and studies at the Screen Actors Studio. Ernest Warnelius has appeared on stage, screen and television and studied at the Vancouver Playhouse Acting School. Viktoria brings a quirky edginess to her role while Ernest displays an emotional range.

Local businesses are getting behind the film as well: filming begins in early May at the Oswego Hotel and Thrifty Foods is donating catering.

CineVic is a Victoria artist-run cooperative facilitating the expression of unique, innovative voices in the ever-evolving language of film.
